ALPINE ACCIDENTS IN 1911.

On January 14, **Henri Gras** was buried by an avalanche while descending from the **Col de Fenêtre** into the Val Ferrex.

On February 19, **Erich von Fischer**, of Berne, was killed on the **Männlichen**. He inadvertently walked on a snow cornice, which gave way, causing him to fall some 300 metres.

On March 6, **Alois Hell**, brother of the keeper of the little inn at Kühtal, situated on the pass between the Grieserthal (Upper Selrainthal) and the Nederthal, which leads to the lower Ötztal, lost his life by an unfortunate accident.

He had accompanied the guide Kress and a lady from Munich up the **Mutt**, a point of view close to the inn.

After a short halt he turned to go home the same way, skiing down with his hands in his pockets. Suddenly the whole snowslope,
